1 Homepage

When you log in to the VLE, the first screen you will see is the homepage. From here, you can access all the areas you will need via the navigation bar.

2 Dashboard

Here, you will see an overview and summary of progress for all programmes and modules you are enrolled on.

3 My Courses

Here, you will see a list of all programmes and modules you are enrolled on.

4 This course

Here, you will see a summary of study resources and activities in the module you are currently viewing.

5 Student Community and Services

Student Community is an area for all students to meet, discuss issues and provide feedback. Student Services are teams who can assist you with various aspects of your study journey. Should you need to contact any of these teams, please use Student Central.

6 Study Skills

This provides valuable guidance on academic writing and referencing, as well as tutorials to help you with your maths and English. Guidance on how to complete assessments can also be found here.

7 e-Library

This contains information relevant to your studies and links to various important websites in the industry sectors. This area includes

subscriptions to online academic libraries and research carried out by UCEM.

8 Module page

Here, you can see a typical module page. Resources and guidance used throughout the module are at the top. Study materials are found underneath in the containers. Click on these to open or close them.

On the right you can see upcoming events, announcements, the calendar and administration block. You can move or hide these using the buttons in the corner. Take some time at the start of the semester to explore and familiarise yourself with your modules so you know where everything is.

9 Breadcrumb trail

If you are unsure where you are on the VLE, look at the breadcrumb trail below the navigation bar. Click on the links to move back to different areas.

10 VLE profile

To view or edit your VLE profile, click on the drop-down menu in the corner of the screen and select the appropriate option.
